

## Deep South Mini Shindig Rules

- ~ Deep South Mini Shindig is a Christian event and all rules are to help reflect Christ in our conduct.
- ~ Please respect all camp properties just as you would at the church you attend. We ask you to assist in keeping the grounds clean of trash. Cans are provided campwide to contain debris.
- ~ Illegal drugs, alcohol, knives, any form of tobacco, guns, skateboards, and fireworks are not permitted. Such items will be confiscated.
- ~ If property or equipment is damaged, you will be held responsible for any cost incurred for repair or replacement.
- ~ Please leave cabins as clean as possible when you leave on Sunday.
- ~ The lake is for canoeing or fishing and not for swimming. Lifejackets must be worn while a camper is in any boat.
- ~ No clothing which is revealing, suggestive, or advertises alcohol or tobacco products will be allowed.
- ~ Swimsuits must be modest - no bikini or monokini-style, and a dark-colored t-shirt and shorts must be worn over swimsuits while at the pool.
- ~ No use of the Ropes Course, Obstacle Course, or 32' Rock Wall is allowed unless Timber Creek authorized, trained personnel are present.
- ~ Campers are not allowed to enter the cabins of campers of the opposite sex.
- ~ Attendance at event sessions is voluntary, but we request that you please be on time to sessions as a matter of courtesy to speakers and other attendees.
- ~ No golf carts, four-wheelers, or ATV's of any kind are allowed on camp except those used by the camp staff or unless pre-approved by camp management.
- ~ The pool is open on Thursday, Friday, and Saturday from 11:00-5:00. No lifeguard on duty.
- ~ Food and drinks are not allowed in the cabins.
